Education:

The applicant shall have completed or be working to achieve a degree in Turfgrass Management or closely related field. Certificate, two-year, or four-year are all acceptable.

Position Description:

This is an entry level Assistant Superintendent position. The ideal candidate will be self-motivated and look to expand their knowledge of plant protectant and fertilizer applications, hand watering, irrigation troubleshooting, tournament preparation and leading small crews to complete special projects. This is an exciting opportunity for someone beginning their career to advance rapidly through hard work and personal achievements.

Course Description:

Aronimink Golf Club was founded in 1896 and moved to its current location in 1926. Donald Ross, the Scottish pro who became one of America's foremost golf architects, was commissioned to design the course. Upon returning in 1948 Ross said of the course, "I intended to make this my masterpiece, but not until today did I realize I built it better than I knew."

Today Aronimink remains in Golf Digest's Top 100 courses in the country. Over the past century, we have hosted numerous prestigious tournaments most notably the 1962 PGA Championship, the 1977 U.S. Amateur Championship, the 1997 U.S. Junior Amateur Championship, 2003 Senior PGA Championship, the 2010 and 2011 AT&T National Championships, and the 2018 BMW Championship. Aronimink Golf Club recently completed its Master Plan Restoration in the spring of 2018, returning the golf course to its vintage look based on aerial and ground photos from 1929, one year after the course opened. Famed architect Gil Hanse lead the design team in restoring 174 original bunkers, reclaiming lost fairway and green space, and reshaping all tees to their natural free-form look. Aronimink showcased these changes during the 2018 BMW Championship, a PGA Tour FedEx Cup Playoffs event. We are also looking forward to the 2020 KPMG Women's PGA Championship and the 2026 Men's PGA Championship.
