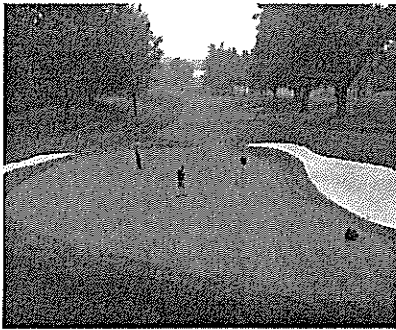
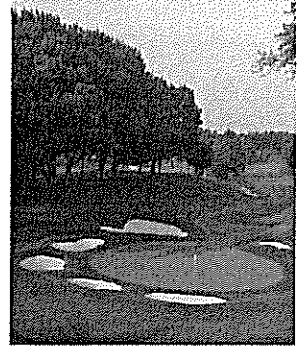

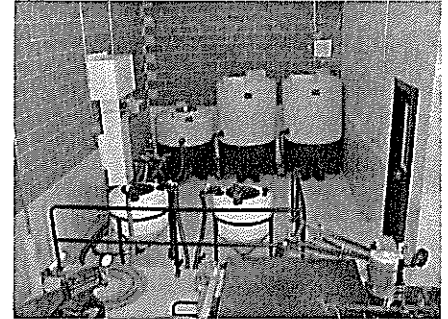
Internship Opportunities
