Come be part of the future of Golf in Madison Parks! The City of Madison Parks Division is hiring for the position of Golf Course Superintendent 1. The successful candidate will play an integral role in maintaining the municipal golf courses in an efficient and effective manner, with the goal of improving course conditions and environmental sustainability practices. This position will work at the Monona, Odana Hills, and Yahara Hills golf courses and The Glen Golf Park. The work is characterized by independent judgment in the technical aspects of golf course maintenance. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Golf Director, Golf Clubhouse Supervisor, or other higher level staff, who reviews the work periodically (through inspection and/or administrative review) for compliance with program objectives.

Glen Golf Park is a 9-hole course was recently renovated through a donation from Michael Kaiser. The renovation coincided with a reimagination of what municipal golf can be. We are currently creating a model for sustainable municipal golf that includes ecological restoration and bringing the entire community to the golf course through non golf programming. This would be a great opportunity for someone to have a lead role at a course but still have the support of superintendents at our three other courses and an irrigation tech.
